PE will be taught on a Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday morning. On a Tuesday the Year 1 children from Class 1 will join us too. This term our PE sessions will focus on gymnastics and developing basic skills. Basic skills include throwing and catching, following instructions and reacting quickly and accurately.

Science this half term is all about ourselves. We will be learning about our bodies and the amazing things they do. After half term we will be moving onto seasons. We'll be looking at seasonal change between Autumn and Winter and signs we might see of seasons changing.

Children will read in school on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. They will then bring their book home to share with you during the rest of the week. Books should always be returned the following Monday ready for the next group.

Autumn Term in Class 2



Mrs Johnson will be teaching us Design and Technology this year. We will be trying, designing and making some healthy snacks - some sweet and some savoury.

Monday will be our library day and your child will bring home 2 library books. Please make sure they are returned the following Monday. Monday will also be our spelling and handwriting day. Please make sure your child brings their spelling book each week.

In RE we will be learning about two different religions between now and the end of the term. During the first half term we will learn about the faith of Islam and then move onto Judaism after half term.

After half term we will move onto Art. Mrs Johnson will also teach us this. We will be focusing on pencil drawing and learning about the work of different artists.

We will start the term with Geography. We will focus on our local area, identifying different landmarks and where we are in the world. We will then move onto learning about castles in History. We will learn about local castles and hopefully will be able to visit one.

Year 1 from Class 1 will also join us for Music. Together we'll be listening and responding using rhythm and different beats - we might even use the Djembe drums!
