
We will start with History this half term and learn about Grace Darling. We will find out why she is famous and what it was like to live when she was young.

After the half term break we will move onto Geography. We will learn about what it's like to live on an island in our Island Homes topic. We will compare this to where we live and look at human and physical features.


We will continue to do PE on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. On a Tuesday, with Class 1 Year 1 children also, we will be developing our skills involving striking and fielding games, as well as athletics later in the term. On a Wednesday we will learn the skill of Tri golf and move on to Sports Day Practise.

In R.E., during the first half term we will be learning about what it means to belong to a faith community. In the second half term we will move onto the importance of caring for others and our world.

Our IT lessons will again be using the Chrome Books.
We will use them to develop our skills with Scratch in the first half term before creating stopmotion animation in the second half term.



## Summer Term in Rainforest Class



Our PSHCE lessons will start with Economic Wellbeing. We will then move onto transition, feelings and emotions and friendships.

In Science we are starting the term looking at Animals including humans. We will then move onto Plants after half term and enjoy a trip to Harlow Carr Gardens to enhance our learning.

Music this term will focus playing instruments and singing. We will listen to ostinato melodies (short repetitive pieces of music) and try to remember these when we play our instruments.
