### Maths

This half term in reception we have focussed on counting out objects accurately 1:1, counting orally forwards and backwards, subitising and singing songs.

In Year 1, we have focussed on number recognition and formation, place value, shape, addition using a number line and fact families using part-whole models.





### English

We have enjoyed sharing traditional tales and acting them out; writing our own Autumn poems; following and writing instructions for baking bread rolls. We have had fun identifying what a sentence is and how to write our own. In reception, we have focussed on recognising and writing our own names, pencil grip and letter formation.
