Polite reminders to help your children

Please help your child to remember the following ...

Earrings - only studs are permitted to be worn in school. These must be removed when swimming. During PE lessons and sport, earrings should be removed or covered with micropore tape.

Long hair - Please can long hair be tied back. This is especially important for safety during PE lessons and is more hygienic when eating lunch. We have had cases of headlice in school over the last few weeks and tying long hair back does help prevent this from spreading.

PE Kit - Please can we remind everyone that sports club kit, football kit and items of clothing with large logos or stripes are not school PE kit. We have tried to ensure that all items of uniform and PE kit items can be purchased reasonably from local stores e.g. supermarkets.
