



End of Key Stage 2 data July 2016

The national curriculum and school performance indicators have changed with scaled scores replacing levels. The expected standard for pupils in 2016 is higher than the expected standard in previous years.

72% of children achieved the expected standard or above in Reading
52% of children achieved the expected standard or above in Writing
64% of children achieved the expected standard or above in Mathematics

36% of children achieved the expected standard or above in
Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined

Average progress score in Reading was -3.9
Average progress score in Writing was -6.2
Average progress score in Mathematics was -4.9

Average scaled score in Reading was 102.6
Average scaled score in Mathematics was 102.5
