Further to this week's letter from Jo Robinson at YCAT, I am pleased to let you know that we will be employing both Bettina (the current mobile cook) and Nikola, our Kitchen Assistant to provide our school meals. Both are looking forward to properly joining the 'Bradleys Both Family' and will be managed by us here at school. I have been pleased with the support that WLP Consultancy Services have provided in helping to prepare us for running the service after the half term break.



The use of School Grid for booking and paying for meals will continue as before. We have been advised that they will be creating new accounts for you and all parent / pupil information will be transferred across. Please can we request that accounts are always kept in credit and that meals are booked by **9.00am** on each day. If your child is not in school due to illness or other absence, we require you to log onto School Grid **before 9.00am to cancel their meal**. After this time the meal will be charged for as the cook will have commenced her preparation. We look forward to you supporting this new and exciting venture. Please do bear with us in the event we have any teething problems in the first few weeks. Further details with menus and dietary needs will be followed up from the office next week.

### Impending Drain Work

You will have noticed a problem we have encountered with the drains running across the playground. We are currently working with YCAT and a specialist contractor to have these repaired. The children are not currently permitted to use or enter the cordoned off area. We hope that any repair work will be carried out with minimal disruption.
