Mobile Phones, Smart Watches and Electronic Devices



The children are **not** permitted to bring a mobile phone, smart watch or electronic device from home into school. Based on the excessive value of these items and the way they can be potentially misused to send messages and capture and share images of other children, it is not appropriate to have them in school. In all instances we must safeguard all children at Bradleys Both. In an extreme case where a mobile phone is to be used as a safety measure for an individual walking

home alone, we would ask that there is a prior agreement between school and the child's parent. In this instance, the mobile phone will be handed into the School Office for secure keeping during the day and then collected at 3.30pm. Our school monitoring and filtering system is able to detect and inform school of the mobile devices within our school site. Thank you in advance for your understanding, help and support with this matter.
