In English we have covered lots of different genres of writing including stories, diary entries and creative poetry.

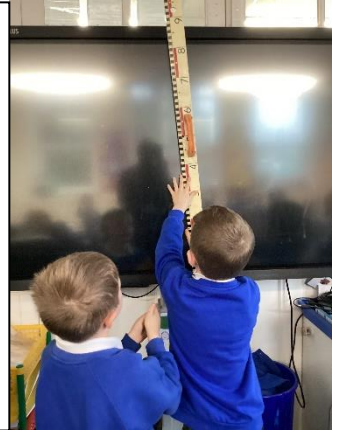
