

Welcome to Class Two!

I hope your child will enjoy their time in Class Two who will be taught by Miss Wright and assisted by Mrs Whitley, Miss Woolly and Mrs Bradley at different times. If you have any questions or would like to look in the classroom please do not hesitate to ask.

P.E. will be on a Monday and a Thursday. Our Monday sessions will be based around developing basic skills such as throwing and catching. On a Thursday we will be skipping to keep fit. After half term we will move onto Gymnastics and Wake Up Shake Up.

In science this term, we will be looking at ourselves, healthy eating and animals. We will be learning about the different groups of animals and answering the question 'are we animals?' To enhance our learning about ourselves we will be going on a trip to Eureka and spending time in the All About Me zone.

In History, children will be learning about Grace Darling. We will learn about her and why she is famous. We will look at how the RNLI have developed over the years and we will also learn about lighthouses.



## Autumn Term in Franklin Class



In the first part of the term we will be painting in our art sessions. We will be learning how to make different colours and shades and looking at work by different artists based on lighthouses.

We're starting R.E. with thinking about what it means to belong to a community. We will explore different communities and faiths and think about the importance of belonging. After half term we will be looking at how and why we celebrate.

After half term we will move from art to design and technology. Here we will be making animal puppets and we might even fit in a bit of Christmas baking!

Your child will now have a reading book and reading record - please help us by writing in the record whenever you have heard your child read. All children will be heard twice a week individually. If your child reads other books at home too please feel free to write this in their reading record too. Please also ask your child questions about their book to help develop their comprehension skills.

Homework will be sent home on alternate Fridays and will be numeracy or literacy. It could be a game to play or a short activity. Spellings will be sent home weekly each Monday and will be tested the following Monday.

In Literacy this term we are focusing on writing sentences using the correct punctuation and ensuring our letters are the right size. We will cover different genres of writing including stories, instructions, letters and poetry amongst others.
