Franklin Class Curriculum Enhancements 2019/2020

Autumn Term

Eureka visit - Wednesday 20th November 2019

Our trip this term links to our science topic of 'ourselves'. We will be spending most of our time in the "All About Me Gallery." This gallery will help the children to extend and consolidate the learning completed in school through hands-on, interactive exhibits. Our third visit will be from 'Into the Wild. Our topic is 'Living Things and their Habitats'. The children will learn and get to understand that animals have different needs and therefore cannot all live in the same place. Into The Wild will bring a selection of creatures, such as snakes, lizards and tarantulas! The session will be interactive and

very informative. We will be asking next year for a voluntary contribution of £5.50 per child which we will add onto Schoolcomms and send out further details nearer the time.
