Edison Visits Curriculum Enhancements 2019/2020

Autumn Term

Harlow Carr – Wednesday 27th November 2019

In Science this term we will be looking at plants, their life cycle and how they adapt to their surroundings. To support this work we will be visiting RHS Harlow Carr and take part in a seed dispersion workshop. We will be asking nearer the time for a voluntary contribution of £13.00 which will cover entry into Harlow Carr and Coach travel. Spring Term

French Café Workshop – Parents Welcome – Thursday 26th March 2020

To develop the children's' learning in French during Modern Foreign Languages (MFL) sessions, the class is going to hold a French Café morning to celebrate their intercultural understanding of France. Having covered the topic of greetings, culture and food through a range of role-play scenarios; the class welcomes parents to join us for an authentic French café workshop to see what's on the menu.

Summer Term

Bradford Science and Media Museum – A study of Light – June 2020

A visit to the National Science and Media Museum – Children will be attending a workshop called 'Light it up!' This workshop explores three modern technologies that work through different properties of light: reflection, refraction and travelling in straight lines. The children will use their scientific knowledge of light to help investigate the three modern technologies which are also known as microscopy, endoscopy and astrophotography. This workshop will help children to develop their learning around light in school. In particular; our need for light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light; that light is reflected from surfaces; that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes; that shadows are formed

when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object and find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change. We will be asking for a voluntary contribution of £11.00 next year for coach travel as both the museum entry and workshop are free. We will add this onto Schoolcomms and send out further details nearer the time.
