

Newton Class Autumn Term



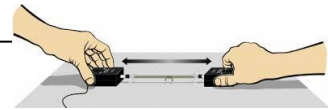
Through our history topic this term we will be investigating The Vikings, we will be learning about raiders, traders and settlers. We will be visiting York to observe real artefacts and find out more...

In literacy we will be researching Sir Isaac Newton and writing his biography. Following this we will be focusing on our choice of reading books and a new Reading Challenge Bingo.

Through our history topic, we will be writing a newspaper report about the Viking raid on Lindisfarne and a diary entry. We will also write non-fiction reports. This term we will also be focusing on reading comprehension and the usual spelling, grammar and punctuation activities.

In computing we will use the chrome books to learn about internet safety, how to carry out research, send emails and create presentations.

In science we will be learning about: Sir Isaac Newton and forces, seed dispersal through art and Earth and Space.



Our French lessons will begin with greetings, conversations, songs, and to fit in with our autobiographies we will create a presentation about ourselves in French



Art activities will start with signs of autumn, including painting with blackberry juice. They will then be planned around our Viking topic: Viking shields, weaving, modroc brooches and Viking runes.
